Nouns (ELAGSE3L1a)-

A Noun is a word that names a person, place, or thing.

A common noun names any person, place or thing.

A proper noun names a particular person, place, or thing. A proper noun begins with a capital letter.

Pronouns (ELAGSE3L1a)-

A pronoun is a word that can take the place of a noun. Use pronouns in your writing so you don't repeat the same noun over and over.

Verbs (ELAGSE3L1a)-

A verb is a word that tells what someone or something does or is.

Some verbs show action. Some verbs do not show action. The verb be tells what someone or something is. Am, is, and are are all forms of be.

Writing:

Writing personal narratives using a student's own experiences, or experiences from their imagination using good technique, descriptive details, and clear event sequences.
