Plural Nouns (ELAGSE3L1b)-

A singular noun is a noun that names one person, place or thing.

A plural noun names more than one person, place, or thing.

Add -es to nouns ending in ch, sh, ss, or x

Nouns that end in a consonant and y, change the y to i and add-es

Irregular plurals change in special ways (man/men, mouse/mice, goose/geese, foot/feet) or do not change at all (deer, moose)!

Abstract Nouns (ELAGSE3L1c)-

Abstract nouns name ideas, feeling, beliefs, or other things that you cannot see, touch, taste, smell, or hear.

Concrete nouns name things you can see, touch, taste, smell, or hear.
