Simple Verb Tenses (ELAGSEL1.e)

The tense of a verb helps readers know when something is happening. Present Tense shows something happening (Present Tense shows something happening now or in the present) (Past Tense shows that something happened before or in the past) (Future Tense shows what is going happen in in the future)

Regular Verbs and Irregular Verbs (ELAGSEL1.d)

Most verbs are regular verbs and end in -ed to show paste tese. However, some verbs are irregular and change in special ways to show past tense.

Subject-Verb Agreement (ELAGSEL1.f.)

The subject of a sentence tells who or what the sentence is about. The verb in the sentence must agree with the subject.

Pronoun-Antecedent Agreement (ELAGSEL1.f.)

Pronouns take the place of nouns. Pronouns must agree with the noun they replace.
